**7:** Turn LEFT onto CHESTNUT RIDGE RD / US-219. Continue to follow CHESTNUT RIDGE RD. 2.6 miles



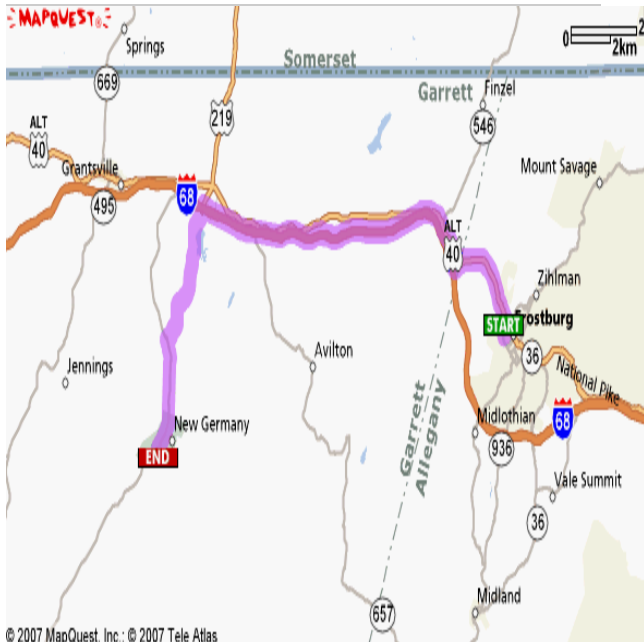
**8:** Turn LEFT onto NEW GERMANY RD. 1.9 miles

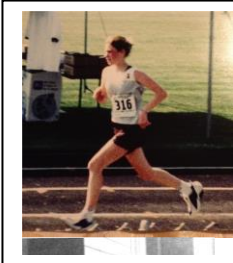
